Minutes of the Review Meeting held on 21/10/11 at 11-30 AM in the Conference Hall of D.C. Office  
Barpeta In respect of Functioning of PDS and "Amar Dukan" Scheme

Sri S. Singh IAS Deputy Commissioner Barpeta presided over the meeting .

At the beginning, all the members present are welcomed from the chair. After a brief introduction of the members, the discussion initiated as per agenda and lifting and distribution position of allotted PDS/TPDS items are reviewed. Accordingly Sri G. Mahanta i/c Deputy Director FCS&CA Barpeta presented the status of lifting of allotted PDS items and distribution amongst consumers during the month of September/2011 . He also explained the status of allotment of PDS items of October/2011 and stated that the allotment orders have been released for the current month but the process of lifting of commodities have not completed yet . Due to arrival of rice under Mukhya Mantrir Anna Suakshya Yojana the demand of APL rice( additional allotment) has decreased and some of the GPSS did not lift their allotted rice. Some of the GPSS and all the urban wholesale Consumers Co-operative have not lifted their allotted quota of atta on the plea of its less demand and high brand content.

The Deputy Commissioner expressed dissatisfaction and directed all the PDS nominees to lift their due share of all allotted items henceforth. The Deputy Commissioner also expressed dissatisfaction on the distribution of S.K.oil and asked all Inspectors/sub inspectors to gear up monitoring and enforcement to detect black marketing of S.K.oil in their respective areas without further delay.

Moving to the agenda, The Deputy Commissioner wanted to know the status of detection of bogus F.I.Card in town areas. Sri S.k. Sihna Inspector stated that the verification has not completed yet and number of bogus F.I.Card will come out after completion of the process. The Chairman expressed dissatisfaction and urged upon completion of the process soon.

The Deputy Commissioner directed all the GPSS and other PDS nominees to submit their transportation bills of Antodaya Anna yojana, Mukhya Mantrir Anna Surakshya Yojana and bills of transporting Mid Day Meal rice to the Food Civil Supplies And Consumer Affairs Branch within next ten days and thereafter to submit the current bills regularly at the time of getting endorsement of monthly quota of PDS articles.

He also directed all the GPSS and Wholesale Consumers Co-operative societies of five urban towns to deposit the value of F.I.Cards issued under Mukhya Mantrir Anna Surakshya Yojana within next fifteen days:

The I/c Deputy Director FCS&CA instructed all Inspectors/sub Inspectors to find out GPSSwise number of MMASY Cards tagged and number of cards issued in the third phase of the scheme and furnish their report within 15 days as the information is urgently required by Director FCS&CA Assam.

Moving to the agenda item 'Amar Dukan' the Deputy Commissioner requested the additional Deputy Commissioner Sri N. Haque to discuss the functioning of amar dukan. Sri N. Haque ADC recalled the discussion held in the last meeting of 7/9/11, asked all the wholesalers and retail amar dukan dealers to gear up the scheme by purchasing and selling more and more items of consumers' demand so that the scheme can be made operative in all the rural areas of the district. As resolved earlier, every GPSS have to open an Amar Dukan in their societies premises or in a F.P.Shop agency at convenient place where people will be able to get their goods. Taking stock of the current price position of market from the wholesale traders the wholesale price and the retail price of rice(swastic brand ),moong dal, masoor dal, moong gota, gramwhole,salt packet,mustard oil packet(anupam and elephant brand) , refined edible oil(fortune brand),potato and onion, washing soap(ok brand),bathing soap (lux and vival brand)and Gur have been fixed as per annexed sheet.

The Inspector FCS&CA in charge of Barpeta Town and Barpeta Road Town are directed to convene meeting with local wholesalers and "Amar Dukan" dealers on each Friday to review and fix the

wholesale and retail consumer price of the week and to monitor the functioning of all amar dukans and wholesalers as well. The Inspectors are directed to submit their report next day to the Deputy Director for necessary apprise of Deputy Commissioner Barpeta.

The Deputy Commissioner also directed all the PDS nominees of the District to ensure timely lifting of all allotted commodities failing which their license will be cancelled for depriving the general consumers of their respective area from getting their due share of allotted PDS/TPDS commodities.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the chair.
