

MINUTES OF THE DISTRICT LEVEL REVIEW MEETING ON ACTIVITIES UNDER
SECONDARY & ELEMENTARY EDUCATION INCLUDING SSA & RMSA HELD ON 10-9-2015
IN THE BEEO CUM BMC OFFICE, MANDIA BLOCK.

Member present: As per annexure -I

The meeting is chaired by Smti Varnali Deka, I.A.S, Deputy Commissioner Barpeta and attended by Officers of Elementary and Secondary Education Department of the District.

The Deputy Commissioner reviewed all activities under Primary and Secondary Education Sector of the District. The following issues were discussed.

1. Construction and repairing of Girls and Boys toilets :

The Junior Engineer of SSA, Mandia Block reported that construction of Girls and Boys Toilets, under, SBA were completed. The Deputy Commissioner asked to submit the non reported left out schools without Boys & Girls Toilets if any in the district. In replying he stated that such type of schools which are yet to be identified due to recent flood will be submitted in the next meeting (action from JE). The Chairperson expressed dissatisfaction over the matter and directed to submit the list within one week (Action from concerned BMC & JE concerned). Further D.C directed the BEEOs to submit the list of schools where Boys and Girls Toilets were constructed with a common wall. The Finance & Accounts Officer, SSA, reiterated that most SMCs do not deduct tax from the party and neither the party deposit the tax themselves, thereby causing great loss to the government exchequer. In this the D.C, Barpeta asked the BEEO/ BMCs to take stringent action against the party.

Construction of KGV Building:

The Finance and Accounts Officer, SSA, Barpeta stated that the construction work of Boundary wall and Internal Electrification of the KGBVs were tendered and the comparative statement along with file was put up to ADC (Edn). The matter is lying with the Finance & Accounts Officer, Zila Parishad, Barpeta. The Chairperson suggested the FAO, SSA, Barpeta to communicate with him and expediate the matter urgently.

1. Progress of Civil works activities under RMSA :

Washim Akram, JE, RMSA reported that the construction works of Model School buildings were 85% completed and construction works of Girls Hostel at Mandia could not be initiated till date due to land problem. The Chairperson directed to complete the remain works by Sept/2015 and the detail progress for this work has to be furnished to D.C within 1 week (Action from I.S, BDC, Barpeta. Further, JE, RMSA, reported that the fund for construction work of all ACR of Sc. Library and computer room are in process to release the SMDC A/C of Barpeta Vidyapith H.S.S, Juroram Pathak Girls High School & Azgar Ali Memorial High School which will start the works immediately.

2. Schools Monitoring:

The BMC, Mandia reported that the teachers from the near by schools were called and asked not to venture out during school time. Further the BMC, Mandia reported that the show cause notice was issued against the H.T of 144 Jania LPS due to closed on 3-8-2015 and 808 No Chapra LPS due to irregularities on MDM on the same day. The Deputy Commissioner directed the BEEO to take stern action (pay cut etc) against the absentee teachers and anomalies found in MDM. The BEEO /BMC assured that if such cases are reported in future there will pay cut of the concerned teacher.

The matter of monitoring report of Bahari Boys MVS and Bahari Girls MVS could not be discussed on as BEEO chenga was absent. The D.C directed the DEEO to serve a show cause notice to him immediately.

On Monitoring of Schools: The Programmer, SSA, Barpeta reported that 56 schools were visited by SSA district officials. On compilation of reports, the average attendance of student was found to be 62%. 13 nos schools were without Boys toilet & 6 Nos of schools were without Girls Toilets and in 6 Nos of schools MDM were not served during school period. The Deputy Commissioner suggested DEEO and concerned BMC to undertake the visit regularly and to take appropriate action against the defaulters.

Photo capturing of pupils by CRCCs: Block wise average photos were captured as follows:

The Deputy Commissioner reviewed the block wise status and expressed dissatisfaction over the progress. All BEEOs reported that most of the schools are reeling under water, backward areas and in some areas data network is very thin. The D.C suggested that the children have to be called in higher places nearby the school and complete the photo capturing within one week.

Retirement: The DEEO, Barpeta reported that list of retirement has already been submitted to D.C office on 9-9-2015.

Enrolment of out of school children : The DPO(STR) told the meeting that 2488 OOSC are already enrolled in the school out of 4588. The D.C desired to improve the intake of OOSC and asked the DPO(ST) to achieve the target by Dec' 2015.

MEM I: Sri P. Mahanta, District Accounts Officer, MDM reported that the block have not submitted the following reports inspite of repeated reminders.

1. Status of Fire Extinguisher at school level.
2. Phone No of Head Master/Head Teacher and 2 most senior teacher.
3. Allocation/Availability of rice at school level on 5th day of next month with signed hard & soft copy.
4. Correct enrolment and correct A/C No of SMC for direct transferring cooking cost & honorarium to cook cum helper from State Nodal Officer through NEFT mode.

The Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta directed the BEEO cum BMC to submit the above reports to DMC, SSA, Barpeta within 1 week.

Further, P. Mahanta reported that the RBSK (Rastriya Bal Sastya Kariyakram) team very rarely visit the school. The Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta asked him to follow up with RBSK & call DPM, NHM, also in the next meeting.

The next review meeting will be held on 8-10-2015 at BMC Office, SSA, Barpeta.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.

MINUTES OF THE DISTRICT LEVEL REVIEW MEETING ON ACTIVITIES UNDER SECONDARY & ELEMENTARY EDUCATION INCLUDING SSA & RMSA HELD ON 8-10-2015 IN THE BEEO CUM BMC OFFICE, BARPETA BLOCK.

The meeting is chaired by Smti Varnali Deka, I.A.S, Deputy Commissioner Barpeta and attended by Officers of Elementary and Secondary Education Department of the District. The Deputy Commissioner reviewed all activities under Primary and Secondary Education Sector of the District. The following issues were discussed.

Construction and repairing of Girls and Boys toilets :

The DPE, SSA, Barpeta reported that 100% construction & repairing works of Girls & Boys Toilets, under SBA were completed by the concerned HT and SMCs. But 14 Nos schools have not received the fund from SMO where the works were completed from concerned H/T. Further he reported that 15 Nos schools are yet to be received the fund for last instalment against the works from NHPC. It was decided for urgent communication with SMO and NHPC to resolve the issue (Action from DPE).

The DEEO, Barpeta asked the BEEOs to submit the non-reported left out schools without Girls & Boys Toilets. In replying DPE, SSA, Barpeta reported that the non reported left out schools without boys and girls toilets will be captured from up coming DISE 2015-2016, SSA, Barpeta. (Action from District Programmer).

On the list of constructed toilets having common wall: In replying the question asked by DEEO, the BMC, Rupshi reported that the concerned technical persons were not communicated to him. It was decided that the concerned technical persons must be attended in their concerned BMO as an when required from the concerned BMO. Other wise the BMCs must report to DMC for necessary action. (Action from BMCs). The Chairperson directed the BEEOs to submit the said list of schools to D.C within 7 days.

Construction works of Boundary Wall and Internal Electrification of KGBV Buildings :

The DPE, SSA, Barpeta reported that the construction works of KGBV buildings of Gobardhana, Barpeta, Pakabetbari and Chenga have been completed and the childrens of those concerned KGBVs may be shifted to the newly constructed buildings before 20th Oct/2015. On this matter, DPO(AS), SSA, Barpeta reported that the shifting of KGBVs will not be possible due to non-completion of the boundary wall and Internal Electrification works as the KGBVs schools are residential school for Girls student and the teaching staff also includes all ladies. The FAO, SSA, Barpeta told that the concerned file is in the DC office itself. The D.C, Barpeta reiterated that it should be persued immediately and order be issued to the parties for KGBV construction. The DPE also assured that the construction works of Boundary wall and the works of Internal Electrification of KGBVs will be completed within 31st Oct/2015 so that the hostel can be shifted to the newly constructed KGBV buildings. (Action from FAO & DPE).

Progress of Civil works activities under RMSA :

Junior Engineer, RMSA reported that the construction works of Model School buildings were 89% completed. The Chairperson asked him when it will be completed. In replying he assured to complete the same within Oct/2015. Further he reported that the fund for construction work of ACR of Science Laboratory and computer room will be release within 7 days to the SMDC A/C of Barpeta Vidyapith HSS, Juroram Pathak, Girls

construction of school building. The Deputy Commissioner suggested to communicate with the concerned circle officer (Action from DPO(AS)).

The next review meeting will be held on 10-11-2015 at BMC Office, SSA, Chenga.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
